Sending Files to T Productions

There are two main ways to submit your artwork. Start by visiting our website:

Software and File Formats

T Productions supports the following design software on both Macintosh and PC platforms:

Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe InDesign, Adobe PDF.

If you use other design software, please export your files in EPS, PDF, PSD or TIFF format.

Compressing your files saves upload time and combines them in a convenient package. Please do so before emailing or uploading.

Artwork Quality and Scaling

T Productions requires files of a certain resolution and size to guarantee a quality product. Files not meeting the following requirements may be subject to additional art time and charges, or may be of insufficient quality.

Vector artwork (Illustrator, Corel, Freehand files or the equivalent) should be scaled to final print size, and colored using the Pantone color matching system. All fonts should be converted to outlines, or included with the document. Placed files should be embedded in the document, or provided separately.

Raster files (Photoshop bitmap or equivalent) should be provided at final print size of 300 pixels per inch (continuous tone/ photographs), or 600 pixels per inch (one bit per pixel black and white images). Color image files should be in RGB Color mode and should not contain any additional layers or channels. Images, to be printed on color garments, should be provided as a single transparent layer.
